The SEHSA Environmental Health and Safety Association, Inc (SEHSA) Conference Committee invites members, non-members, organizations, and vendors to submit abstracts for presentations on environmental, health, and safety topics.

Abstract Submission Requirements:

- Presentations will be given on April 19th and 20th. Presentations must be no longer than 45 minutes including time for questions and answers.
- Abstracts must be no longer than 250 words and must briefly describe what attendees can expect to learn from your presentation.
- Abstracts must be submitted using the SEHSA Abstract Submission Form and sent via email, fax, or mail.
- All Abstract Submission Forms must be received no later than February 26, 2010.
- Presentations must be of a technical nature.
- Vendors are welcome to submit abstracts as long as the presentations are of a technical nature and not a sales pitch or a commercial. Vendors violating this rule will be prohibited from future presentation opportunities.

- All presenters must register for the conference and pay associated conference registration fees.

Changes, Cancellations, and Withdrawals:

- The SEHSA Conference Committee considers the submission of an abstract as a commitment to present. Presenters failing to meet their commitment to present may be prohibited from future presentation opportunities.
- If extenuating circumstances prevent the delivery of a presentation, the presenter has a responsibility to notify the SEHSA Conference Committee as soon as possible and to assist in finding a suitable alternative presentation. Failure to provide notification in a timely manner or failure to assist with finding an alternative presentation may result in the presenter being prohibited from future presentation opportunities.

Presentation Selection Process

- The SEHSA Conference Committee will evaluate abstracts based on quality, relevance, originality, technical merit, and prior presentations (if applicable).
- Abstracts must be submitted using the SEHSA Abstract Submission Form and sent via email, mail, or fax.
- Submission of abstracts after the Call For Papers deadline will not be considered unless the Call For Papers deadline is extended by the SEHSA Conference Committee.
- Sponsorship of the conference by vendors is not a requirement, nor is a guarantee, for the opportunity to present.
- The SEHSA Conference Committee reserves the right to accept or reject any abstracts that are submitted.
